 Our standard **species** datasearch is post-1995 records for rare, threatened or protected species; species with a Biodiversity Action Plan or statement and species with a Dorset Notable status, plus records for invasive alien plants within/in the vicinity of your chosen area. Records are provided on an Excel spreadsheet.
 In addition we can also provide **printed maps** showing site boundaries. We will check for international conservation sites, Sites of Special Scientific Interest, Sites of Nature Conservation Interest, Regionally Important Geological Sites, Local Nature Reserves, Dorset Wildlife Trust Reserves, Conservation Verges, Sites on the Inventory of Ancient Woodland, World Heritage Sites and Areas of Outstanding Natural Beauty.
 DERC can also provide **habitat data** for some areas and **marine data** from the Dorset Marine Biodiversity Database.
